The City of Benbrook encourages commercial development. A strong business community enhances economic growth, stability, and quality of life. The City of Benbrook regulates the use of signage and other advertising to maintain the City's appearance, to attract economic growth and development, and to promote safety.

Signs in Benbrook are allowed based upon certain factors, including the zoning district and the area, height, type, number, and placement of signs. Businesses and non-commercial entities are required to obtain a sign permit from the Benbrook Inspections Department prior to placement of most signs. Obtaining a sign permit is easy and inexpensive, and ensures that your advertising dollars are not wasted on signage that may not be allowed. Please call or visit the Inspections Department to obtain a sign permit prior to investing in signs, banners, pennants, and other advertising items.

For new businesses holding a "grand opening", or for existing businesses and non-commercial entities wishing to host a special event, provisions in the sign ordinance allow for a 'special event' sign permit. A special event sign permit allows the use of temporary banners and pennants for a period of 30 consecutive days in a calendar year.
