

Annexation Plan

(excerpted from Comprehensive Plan)

With the exception of a small area of road right-of-way along Chapin Road, the City of Benbrook is entirely surrounded by the City of Fort Worth and has no extraterritorial jurisdiction. The City has a total area of 7,762.6 acres and a perimeter of 27.94 miles.

While constrained by the Fort Worth boundary, the two cities will continue to evaluate and consider land swaps where it is mutually beneficial to adjust the boundary.

6.6.1 Compliance with Section 43.052, Local Government Code

In 1999, the Texas Legislature significantly amended the annexation statutes to require that every City have an annexation plan and that the annexation of certain types of areas is severely limited. The City has reviewed the expansion needs of the City and limited extraterritorial jurisdiction and has determined that the City does not intend to annex any territory that is required to be in an annexation plan under Section 43.052 of the Local Government Code.
